

## **City to Hold Public Meeting on EPA Brownfields Grants**

The City of Elyria will hold a community meeting at 6:00 p.m. on March 30, 2010 in Council Chambers at Elyria City Hall, 131 Court Street, Elyria, Ohio. Residents, developers and interested parties are encouraged to attend to learn more about the City's existing US EPA Brownfields assessment grants. In July of 2008, the City received \$200,000 for assessment of hazardous substances and \$200,000 for assessment of petroleum substances for Brownfields sites within Elyria. The meeting will provide an update about projects on which funding has been spent, eligible activities that may be conducted with the remaining grant monies and will provide a forum for public input and questions. Comments will be taken into consideration during the utilization of grant monies and prioritization of potential Brownfields sites.
