The Committee voted to continue their agreements but they are not set to get an abatement this year.

The committee will look at their numbers again next year to see how their performance will be at that time.

Mr. Callahan said this is fantastic that the City continues to work together with private industry and these agreements which benefits the City, the companies and the employees.
