

# lifeguard certification classes

FIRST TIME: \$225 | RE-CERTIFICATION: \$125

This American Red Cross class is for ages 15 and older. Successful completion will allow participants to receive a two year certification in Lifeguard Training, First Aid and CPR/AED. All participants must pass the prerequisite swim tests administered during the first session. The tests consist of a continuous 300 yard swim (front crawl and breaststroke with proper technique required), retrieval of a ten pound weight from a depth of 9 feet; and two minutes of treading water not using arms.

Internet access for off site instruction is needed. Attendance is mandatory to complete the course.


