## **4. REMARKS AND REPORTS OF CITY OFFICIALS:**

#### <u> Mayor:</u>

Mayor Brubaker provided an update regarding the 250<sup>th</sup> birthday of the United States. He shared planning is underway with Parks and Rec. Director Reardon for a celebration in collaboration with the 4<sup>th</sup> of July activities on July 3<sup>rd</sup>, 2026. Any one with additional ideas are welcome to reach out to Director Reardon. Bidding for the CMG complex will officially go out on November 28<sup>th</sup>, December 10<sup>th</sup> a recommendation on the project will be made. The last update provided by Mayor Brubaker was that the city of Elyria was awarded two of fifty-one grants that were awarded by the state of Ohio, Elyria received the two grants for Lorain County. Both units will bring a combined \$76 million in investments into the city.

Council member Schneider inquired if the development by the old Maplewood school would be off the table. Mayor Brubaker stated it would not be off the table, it would be placed on a waiting list with the state.

Council member Siwierka inquired on a railroad update. There has been no update. Council member Oswald asked if a traffic study was necessary on West River Rd. Mayor Brubaker shared he does think it is prudent.

#### SSD:

Safety Service Director Pyanowski shared that on Saturday October 18<sup>th</sup>, the City of Elyria hosted its inaugural Touch A Truck event at Lorain CCC. There were over an estimated one-thousand attendees. The event was very well received, many compliments were given. The engagement with city workers was well received. SSD Pyanowski thanked Megan Pugh for facilitating the event and all of the employees that assisted in the successful day. The first draft of the ambulance study has been received. The week of October 27<sup>th</sup> meeting s will begin with department heads to discuss 2026 budgets.
