Robert Baron, Builders and Developers, 27201 Royalton Road, Columbia Station. Requesting approval of a zoning change to an existing parcel that is zoned RMHL to RMHH, which is the current zoning for the balance of the parcel. The site total is 9.6 acres. With the zoning change, it will allow twenty-three buildings with four units each to be built. All buildings will be single story with a private entrance. Two separate driveways, one off of Brunswick and one off of West Ridge Road. Parking will be concrete pavement, with a detention pond that will manage to the stormwater. The sanitary sewer will be located off of Brunswick Drive and water will be available at both entranceways. Site plan listed for preview.

SSD:

Safety Service Director Pyanowski provided an update on the street scanning report, it is in the final stage. The recent paving work that was completed will be added and the report will be disseminated.

Council member Oswald inquired about the process of the veteran banners. SSD Pyanowski explained the lifespan of the downtown veteran's banners has held up longer than anticipated. The original plan for the banners were to hang for three years and be provided to the family members. Additional space is being explored, in addition leadership changes have occurred at the Elyria Veterans Council. There is uncertainty surrounding cost due to transition. More information will be shared with council as it develops.

Council member Siwierka inquired about one of the utility accounts associated with upcoming Resolution 2025-51 that reflects "waiting on a leak credit" SSD Pyanowski shared that whatever

amount remaining will be applied, he will confirm the amounts with PWS Connor to confirm the correct amount is certified with the auditor.

Council member Cerra asked for confirmation regarding leaf pick-up and if it will continue into the first part of December or until the first snowfall. SSD Pyanowski shared that continuance of leaf pick-up is reflective of the need. Last year crews were able to continue through mid December. Leaf pick-up schedule will be communicated when cut-off is near.

Council member Schneider inquired of the compost facility closing date. The compost facility is closed from December through March.

Finance Director:

Finance Director Pileski shared that the October Income Tax Report was distributed and the income tax revenues from 2024 compared to 2025 are up 6.58% which is considerable growth and good news. The bad news is the cash balance in the general fund comparison is down \$2,089,540.00. Income tax revenue is not enough to cover expenditures that are being incurred.

Law Director Deery:

Law Director Deery shared that on Thursday November 19th her office would be participating in the ninth district court of appeals argument with respect to the former Days Inn ownership's challenge to the assignment of the receivership. There is no date as to a decision, however it typically does take at least sixty to ninety days for the ninth district after an oral argument to render a decision. A purchase agreement on the property is being finalized with the receiver. The ownership for Days Inn has also filed a federal lawsuit. The next status will be available in March.

Council member Davis, asked if it will be required to be in writing that the property has to be demolished. Law Director Deery explained that the "in transfer that the nuisance as is set forth in Ohio Law and in the court, order be abated."

Council member Mitchell inquired about an update from DBR. Law Director Deery stated no signed documentation has been received and that the city has not heard from DBR. The City of Elyria has signed documentation. Law Director Deery shared she understands that Elyria City Schools has not received signed documentation either.

Council member Siwierka inquired about the zoning for the Days Inn property, what else would be allowable at that location? Law Director Deery asked if that area would be a part of the overlay? Building Official Farkas explained it is not a part of the overlay, he believes it is zoned business general district, which is the most user- friendly district in the zoning code. BO Farkas stated he would have to defer to City Planner Schoenig regarding the re-write of the zoning. City Planner Schoenig shared that area is commercial zoning to allow most flexibility, similar to business general. The other district which permits more residential uses would be the corridor district which will allow town home uses in that area as well.

Law Director Deery stated that a status update for DBR is scheduled for December 16th.

City Planner Schoenig explained the information in the proposed zoning draft is for there to be a database for the uses. A current rental database exist that is underutilized. The intent is that the owners are registered with the city and the information would be provided to safety services.


