The recreation centers on Saturday mornings are packed with youth sports. Our youth basketball leagues and clinics are bringing excitement to our city at East and South Recreation Centers. Two leagues (ages 5-6 and 7-9) are being held at South Rec Center and one league (ages 10 – 12) is at East Rec Center. Also, we currently offering a 13 – 16-year-old clinic at East Rec immediately following games. In addition to the aforementioned programs, we have soccer clinics and basketball clinics at South Rec on Monday evenings and a 3-4-year-old youth basketball program at South Rec on Tuesdays. Over at West Recreation Center, we are offering a Youth Volleyball Clinic that is generating excitement for the upcoming Youth Volleyball League which begins this weekend. We have over 190 participants registered to play this Winter in the Youth Volleyball League!
